Music Scholarships

Cyber Tech Career College invites student who plays an instrument to apply for a music scholarship. To be awarded this music scholarship, the recipient must have completed high school with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0. and must exhibit proficiency in reading music and playing an instrument. The demonstration of proficiency will be based on the application, and an audition recording. See guidelines below.

Eligibility

Music Scholarships are for students who want to be part of the College's performing band and are non-music majors. Successful Applicants must be 17 years or older and is open to Bahamians as well as non-Bahamians who has attended high school in The Bahamas.

Applications are due on or before the Fourth Wednesday of June each year for consideration for the Fall Trimester. Scholarship recipients will be selected based on demonstrated music excellence.

Applications are reviewed and interviewed by a selection committee which examines the applicant's musical, academic, and leadership qualifications, looks for evidence of team player and extra-curricular involvement as well as recommendations from high school teacher's/guidance counsellors, music teacher or community leader. Selected applicants are invited to campus for an interview after which recommendations are forwarded to the President for final approval.

- Music Scholarships are partial tuition grants. The scholarship is renewable annually for up to two years as long as the student maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0, while contributing practically to the success of the performing band.
- Specifically, scholars:
 - Receive a music scholarship of up to 35% of tuition fees per trimester to cover tuition and related Cyber Tech Career College expenses.
 - are mentored by the Cyber Tech Career College band director.
 - Attends regular team practice, maintains academic standards and is a role model to other band members.

- **If the musician has a GPA below 2.0, the student must enroll in our College Prep program.**

Requirements

- To remain eligible for the award, the musician must:
 - Join the college's performing band.
 - Attend regular band practice,
 - participate in service-learning activities,
 - join at least one campus organization,
 - assist with Cyber Tech Career College's programs and activities,
 - participate in the College's recruitment exercises,
 - be an ambassador of the College,
 - be mentored by the band director.
- maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 every Trimester;
- enroll in a minimum of 12 credit hours per Trimester;

Application Process

- Submit the online Music Scholarship Application.
- Send a recording of you playing to Cyber Tech Career College. The entire recording should not exceed six minutes in length. Recording formats can be MP3, MP4 or YouTube link.
- Please see below "Recording Guidelines" section to understand what your recording should include.

Recording Guidelines

Instrumentalists will perform two contrasting selections
Percussionists will perform one snare drum and one mallet piece.

Required Documents (Music Scholarship)

- The completed Scholarship Application Form.
- Applicant must be a registered student of Cyber Tech Career College before the Early Registration Period ends and must have an acceptance letter from CTCC.
- Copy of any one of these I.D (Driver's License, National Insurance Card, Passport).
- One passport size photo attached to the application.
- Current GPA and most recent High School report.

- Two Character References from a non-family member. Preferably from a current or past employer, high school teacher, pastor or community leader
- Copy of High School Transcript.
- Copies of Academic Qualifications - High School Diploma/GED, Certificates (BJC, BGCSE, SAT, ACT, CXC's AP, College Prep, Diplomas, Degrees).
- Copies of extra-curricular awards and certificates.
- If a student does not have the required BGCSE's or equivalent, they can enroll in our College Prep Program.
- Clean Police Record, no more than six months old
- Cyber Tech Career College Counselor interview.

Mature Students

Applicants over the age of 20 who do not hold one of the recommended academic entry qualifications may also apply for this scholarship providing they have been in full time employment in their respective field of study for a minimum of 2 years and can produce a letter from their employer.

Non-Bahamian Students

Cyber Tech Career College welcomes non-Bahamian students. All non-Bahamians or Permanent residence can also apply for this scholarship. Student must comply with all laws outlined by The Bahamas Immigration Department.

Transfer Students

Cyber Tech Career College accepts students transferring from other institutions recognized and registered by The National Accreditation and Equivalency of The Bahamas (NAECOB).
