Cyber Tech Career College President's Scholarship is a unique two-year, academic scholarship, involving personal development and leadership. This award is available to the best student, who graduates at the top of his or her class, fosters intellectual growth, refines leadership skills and enhances the relationship with Cyber Tech Career College. Scholars are united in their commitment to the pursuit of excellence and service before self and are encouraged to work and learn together.

The Award of President's Scholarship

All high school seniors with a cumulative high school GPA of 3.50 who display outstanding leadership capability and potential should apply for the scholarship. Applications are due on or before the Fourth Wednesday of June each year for consideration for the Fall Trimester. Applications are reviewed by a selection committee which examines academic qualifications, evidence of leadership skills and extra-curricular involvement as well as recommendations from high school teacher's/guidance counsellors, principals or community leaders. Selected applicants are invited to campus for an interview after which recommendations are forwarded to the President for final approval.

The President's Scholarship is a full academic scholarship. The scholarship is renewable annually for up to two years as long as scholars maintain high academic standards while exercising practical leadership in Cyber Tech Career College activities and the wider community.

Specifically, scholars:

- Receive an academic scholarship of up to 50% of tuition fees per trimester to cover tuition and related Cyber Tech Career College expenses
- Is mentored by the President of Cyber Tech Career College.
- is supported by the College to maintain a healthy lifestyle and utilize effective strategies to manage stress and interpersonal relationships.
- Participate in a comprehensive leadership development program.
- Are able to study abroad in a foreign country.

Requirements

- The recipient is required to:
 - attend a leadership retreat before the start of each fall semester,
 - attend leadership workshops and seminars,
 - participate in service-learning activities,
 - join at least one campus organization,
 - assist with Cyber Tech Career College's programs and activities,
 - participate in the College's recruitment exercises,
 - be an ambassador of the College,
 - be mentored by the President or his appointee,
 - complete a one-hour leadership training session each week; and
 - complete a leadership report at the end of every trimester.

To remain eligible for the award, scholars must:

- maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.50 every trimester;
- enroll in a minimum of 12 credit hours per trimester;
- complete 20 hours of community service per trimester; and
- participate in a comprehensive leadership development program.
