Please Collect Deposit Slips from Cyber Tech Career College Admissions Office. Tuition fees must be paid in full at least three weeks before class starts. Only the Registration Fee and any Late payment fees will be collected at Cyber Tech Career College Business Office. There will be no over the counter tuition payments at Cyber Tech Career College's Business Office.

GENERAL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Student must be 17 years of age before the start of the first semester
- Students desirous of entering the Associates Degree Programme must be a high school graduate with a minimum of 3 BGCSE's with grades "C" or better in English Language and Mathematics and must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0
- All Applicants must have a High School Diploma or GED.
- If a student does not have the required BJC/BGCSE subjects or equivalent, they must take an Entrance Examination and enroll in our BJC/BGCSE/College Preparatory Classes.
- Medical Certificate from a qualified medical physician.
- Clean Police Record, no more than six months old
- Cyber Tech Career College Counselor interview.
- Two Character References from a non family member. Preferably from a current or past employer, high school teacher or pastor.

Mature Students

Applicants over the age of 20 who do not hold one of the recommended academic entry qualifications may also register for courses providing they have been in full time employment in their respective field of study for a minimum of 2 years and can produce a letter from their employer.

International Students
